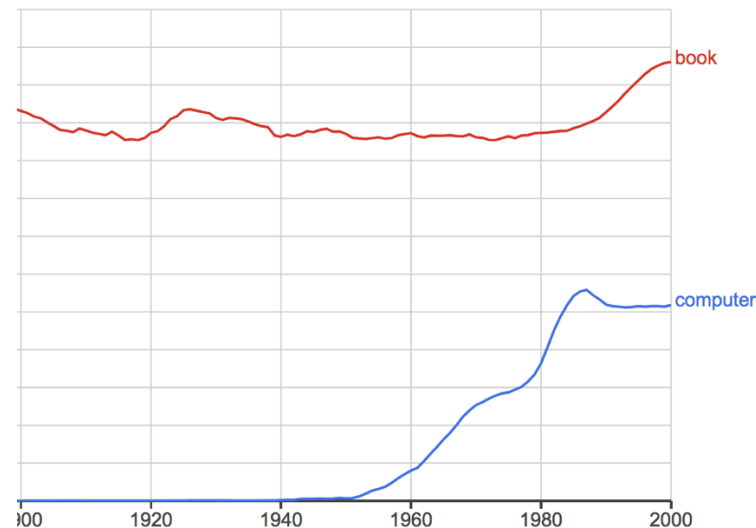


Want to explore **ADVANCED** digital text analysis methods?
