I. Eligibility:

Any Master's or Ph.D. student from the departments of French, History, or Political Science who will be studying or conducting research in France during the summer of 2019 or during the 2019-2020 academic year.

Please note that you must show that you have financial need by submitting the free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the appropriate academic year (2018-19 for summer travel; 2019-20 for academic year travel)

II. Supporting Documents:

- A. A current vitae
- B. A description of the applicant's course of study or of the proposed research project or academic activities that the applicant will pursue while staying in France with justification that the work can only be carried out in France
- C. A letter of support from a faculty member in the applicant's department
- D. An unofficial transcript
- E. After returning from abroad, the applicant should report on their findings to their academic department.
