

What is a Duo Display token?

A display token is a small device that displays a security code at the press of a button. That security code can be entered on the Duo login screen in place of a push notification or text message.

Display tokens are considered a last resort option as they:

- · Can easily be stolen, lost and damaged
- Can get out of sync
- · Are one more thing you need to remember to carry with you

Can I use my own personal U2F device?
