ENFORCEMENT OF LAW

Examples....

Monitor Compliance <i>How government determines if the law is being obeyed</i>	
Reinforce Compliance <i>Incentives government provides that encourage compliance</i>	
Punish Non-compliance <i>Penalties government gives to deter non-compliance</i>	

JUDICIAL branch of government

- ☐ “Due Process” for determining whether someone charged with non-compliance is guilty & the appropriate penalty
